Have at least 1 hospital that does not have a drug take-back location.

Final Summary:

There are 30 total drug take-back location in Indiana Region 10. These organizations include hospitals, pharmacies, Sheriff's Departments, Police Departments, Coroner's Offices, Water Departments, Fire Departments, and Solid Waste Management Departments. Several counties have gaps involving the items they will take-back. Most counties included on this report do not take-back needles, syringes or sharps, which can lead to a rapid spread of disease. Next steps may include getting more information from each of the take-back locations to see the utilization rates of their location and the types of drugs/paraphernalia that is being dropped-off.
